

GET READY FOR YOUR COVID-19 VACCINE!

FOLLOW THESE TIPS TO ENSURE A **FAST** AND **EASY** VACCINE APPOINTMENT.

MAKE AN APPOINTMENT!



Appointments are easy to find by calling your local pharmacy, calling **877-VAX-IN-VA**, or going to **vaccinate.virginia.gov**



Avoid peak pharmacy hours if possible (4-6 p.m.)



Fill out all fields in appointment scheduler **online** (including insurance fields for pharmacy appointments)

PREPARE FOR YOUR APPOINTMENT:



Wear clothing that allows the vaccine clinic staff to work with your **upper arm**



Bring a **bottle of water** to your appointment to stay hydrated

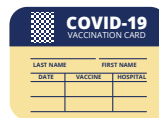


Bring a **book** or **magazine** to help you relax during the observation period (about 15 minutes)

AT YOUR APPOINTMENT:



Not required, but if you have **insurance card**, have it ready (for pharmacy appointments)



Have your COVID-19 **vaccine card** ready (for additional doses or booster doses)

DID YOU KNOW?

- Patients have the right to ask to see the **vial/amount** drawn up before getting their vaccine
- The Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine for children (**5-11**) has an **ORANGE** cap. It uses the same main ingredients as the adult vaccine but at a lower dose
- You can get your **flu shot** or other vaccines at the same time as the COVID-19 vaccine
- Booster doses are now **authorized** for everyone 18 years and older
