



















ACT for Alexandria, in collaboration with the City of Alexandria's Department of Community & Human Services and American Rescue Plan Act funds, has awarded \$400,000 in Emergency Support Grants to 7 Alexandria organizations to provide tangible aid to residents impacted by the effects of the pandemic.
